

Noblesse Palace

Noblesse Palace is the first eclectic building in Bucharest and a historical monument built in 1881 by the famous architect Alexandru Savulescu.

The building is an architectural and cultural jewel of Bucharest, covering 135 years of representative existence. The building has known many historical periods: from the aristocratic beauty of the Berkowitz period, the nationalization period (the Palace of Pioneers), to the post-communist and the abandonment period.

In 2012 the palace is bought by Noblesse Group International, owner of several brands with experience in interior design and cultural industries.


After a complex process of consolidation, restoration of the original elements and interior design, the building became what it is today: one of the most important centers of culture, art and design, a unique concept in Europe.
